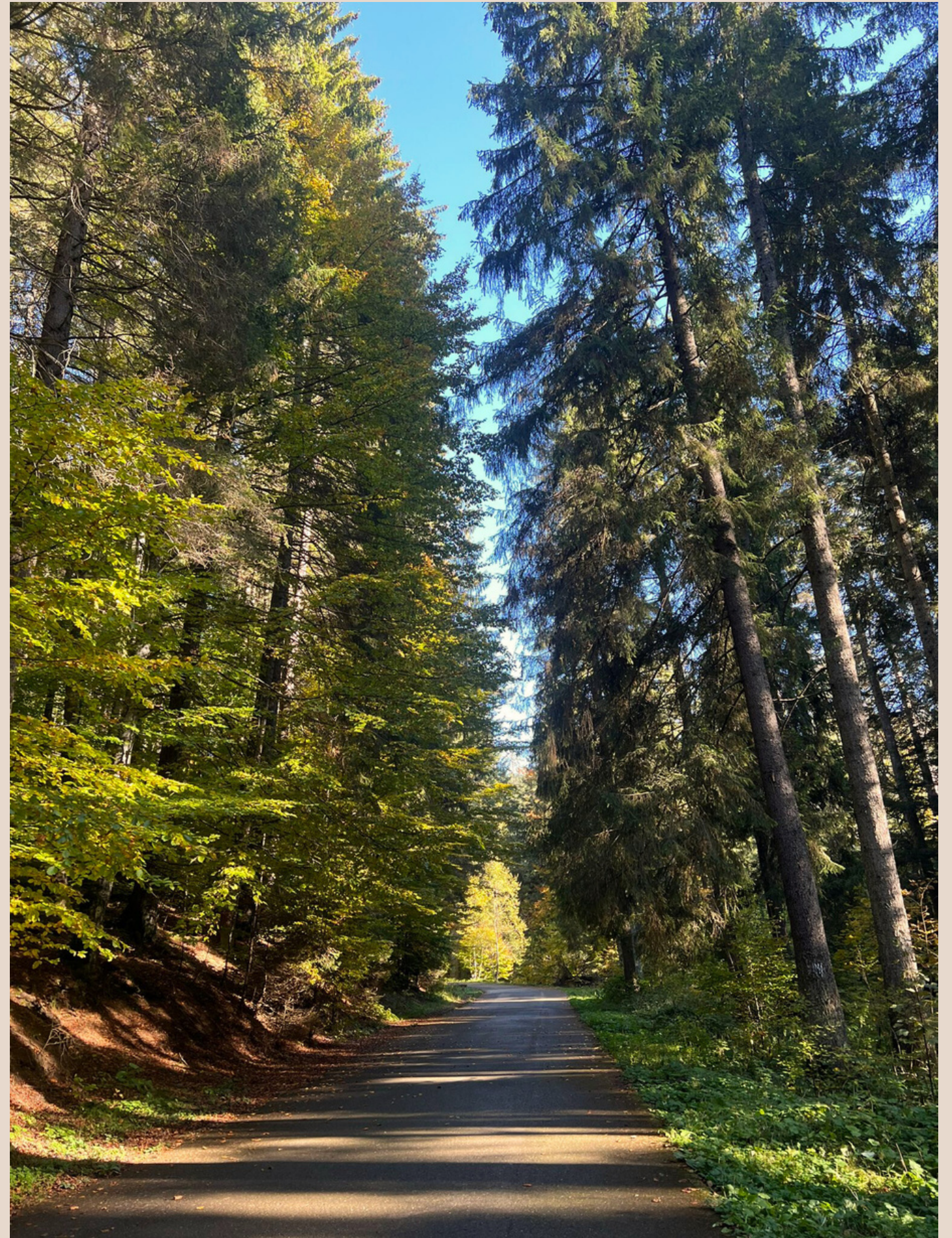
Nature is the greatest artist. We've captured its beauty in pictures of our country and abroad.

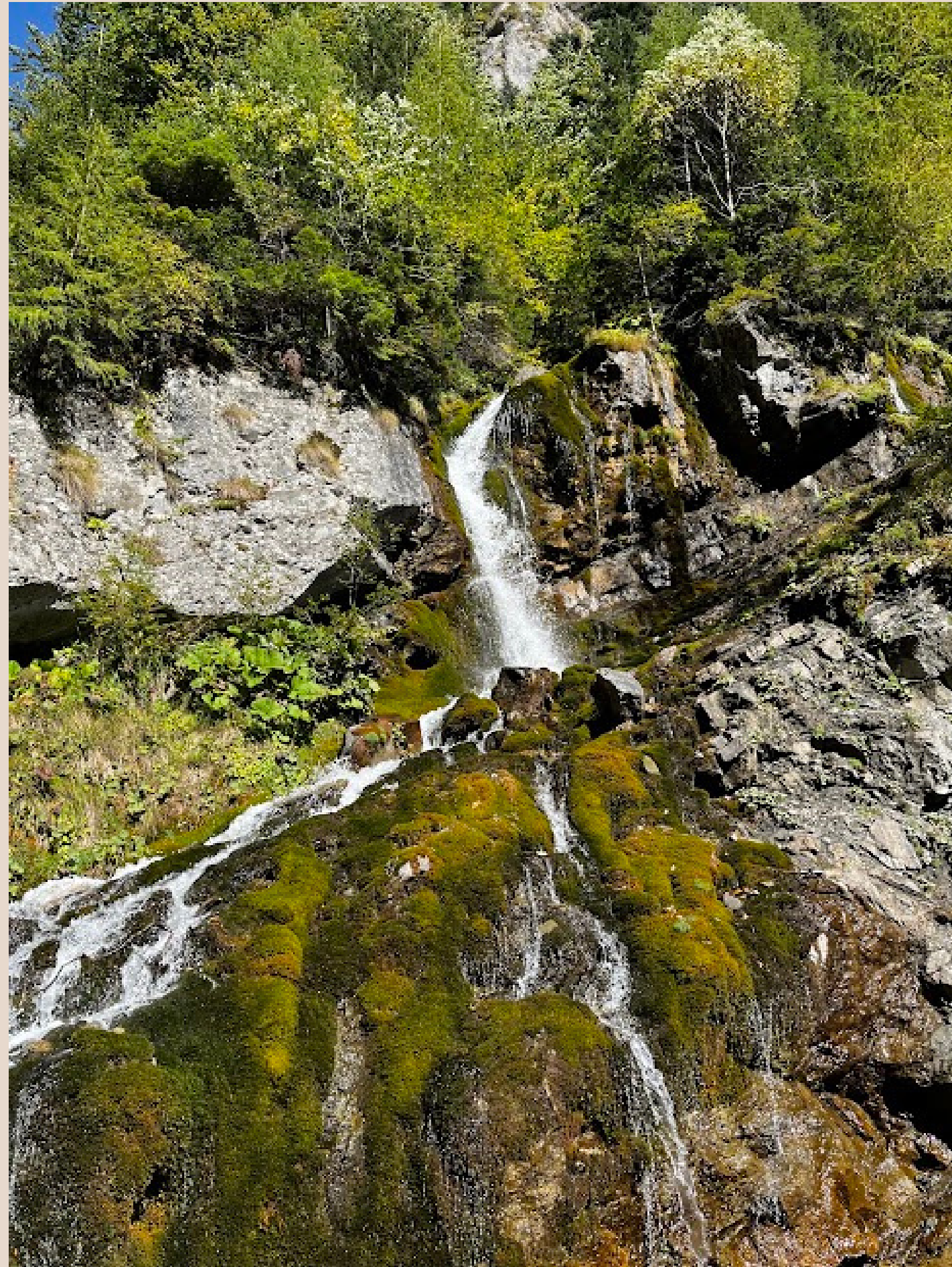
PHOTO 1
